# **Pineapple Cheese Ball**

2 (8 oz) packages cream cheese softened 1 large can crushed pineapple, well-drained 2 tablespoon s green onions- finely chopped 1/4 cup green pepper, finely chopped 2 teaspoons seasoned salt 2 cups pecans, chopped and toasted, divided Crackers

Mix cream cheese and pineapple with a mixer. Stir in onion, green pepper, seasoned salt, and 1/2 cup pecans. Roll into 1 large ball or 2 logs, or fill a scooped-out pineapple half. Roll in or top with remaining pecans. Serve with crackers. This freezes well, and looks great shaped into an elongated pineapple with a pineapple top and bottom. Yield 20-30 servings.
